CITIZEN COMMENTS: No members of the public were present.

CONFIRMATION OF AGENDA ITEMS: Chairperson Bonnie Saxton requested confirmation of the meeting agenda.

- 2. Lease holder of the building located at 705 SE Coast Hwy, Newport, would like to extend purchase agreement option to the District until 2021.

Chairperson Bonnie Saxton requested a motion that the District will notify the owners of the building (located at 705 SE Highway, in Newport) of the District's interest to start the process of exercising the original lease agreement, which is to purchase the building in 2019. David Long moved to accept the action. Ralph Breitenstein seconded. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

HOSPITAL REPORT: Lesley Ogden reported information on the following:

The CEO, COO, and VP of Nursing continue Leadership Rounding for hospital departments and clinics. Employee forums will continue during September. Updates about recruiting and recent hires were shared in addition to hospital statistics for the month of August.
