<u>CALLED TO ORDER:</u> Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD, called the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors to order at 4:00 p.m., in the Center for Health Education at Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital.

<u>CONFIRMATION OF AGENDA ITEMS:</u> Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD requested confirmation of the meeting agenda and asked to move Joe Kunkel's presentation of Phase Two-Budget update following the minutes approval.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** After review of the July15, 2019 Regular Board Meeting minutes, Ralph Breitenstein asked for a motion to approve the minutes as presented.

Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD, requested a motion to approve the minutes. Bonnie Saxton moved to approve the minutes. David Long, MD seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

## **BOARD ITEMS/ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:**

<u>PHASE TWO – BUDGET:</u> Joe Kunkel updated the Board of the Phase 2 of the budget report highlighting where the contingency funds are being utilized. Exterior studs; floor vibration issues; old ambulance bay; deck edge; fill material for the old helipad and basement and moisture mitigation.

Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD, requested a motion to approve the request for \$325,398 from the contingency Bond & Interest money. David Long, MD, moved to approve the request and Kath Schonau seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

**FINANCIAL REPORTS:** Kathryn Doksum presented the following July financial reports for review and approval: Bond Requisition and Interest Summary; Check Register; Balance Sheet; Capital Fund; PCHD Debt Service Fund; and the District Fund Report, which included paid invoices as of August 6, 2019.

Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD requested to approve the financials via email vote due to a missing page from the Board Packet.

**LEGAL REPORT FROM COUNSEL:** Jim Shepherd reported that their office has received the appraisal for the PFS Building purchase. The Appraisal came in at \$970,000 with a 60-day acceptance clause.

Chairperson Ralph Breitenstein, MD, requested a motion to proceed to accept the appraisal of \$970,000. David Long, MD, moved to accept the appraisal request Bonnie Saxton seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

**HOSPITAL REPORT:** Jane Russell, COO reported that Samaritan has been awarded two grants to develop a Rural Training Track Family Medicine Residency Program for the coast. \$500,000 from OHA and \$750,000 from HRSA. The goal is to have residents enter this program beginning July of 2022. The Patient and Family Advisory Committee is being re-energized. SPCH worked with consultants to Ignite the Patient Experience to improve our HCAHPS scores and raise our CMS star rating. SPCH received a 2018 AHA/ASA Stroke Gold Plus Quality Achievement Award.

Quality & Service Excellence report reviewed for: Inpatient; Emergency Room; Primary Care Clinics; Specialty Clinics; Support Services; Community Partnership; Sustainability; and Employee Engagement.

Currently Recruiting for the following: Family Medicine; two Hospitalists; a Pediatrician; a Licensed Clinical Social Worker; a Psychiatric, APC; Psychologists and a General Surgeon.

**CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS:** Jon Conner had nothing to add to Joe Kunkel's detailed hospital update.
